## Normative Aspects of the Use of Military Force

### Aims & Scope

The Journal of Military Ethics is a new, international, peer-reviewed journal devoted to normative aspects of military force. The journal will publish articles discussing justifications for the resort to military force (*jus ad bellum*) and/or what may justifiably be done in the use of such force (*jus in bello*).

The Journal of Military Ethics aims to include articles from a variety of academic disciplines and cultural backgrounds. Articles may adopt theoretical, empirical, or historical approaches.

Two issues will appear in 2002, three in 2003, and from 2004 onwards four issues will appear yearly.

## **Instructions for Authors**

### **Submission**

Authors are encouraged to submit the initial draft, in English, electronically by email. Once the paper has been approved and accepted, the author should submit four hard copies of their manuscripts together with a corrected electronic file, original illustrations and a covering letter to the Editor. It is assumed that the author will keep one copy. Full articles should normally be between 4000 to 8000 words in length. Shorter articles, normally 1000 to 2000 words, are also welcome. Lengthier articles may also be considered. Word, Wordperfect or ASCII files are acceptable. All papers should be previously unpublished and will be subject to peer review, ordinarily by two external reviewers. All received articles will be considered. ### **The Manuscript**

Manuscript may be typed double-spaced on one side of A4 paper only, with a 4cm left-hand margin. Permission to reproduce previously published material or to use illustrations that identify individuals must be obtained by the author prior to submission. Information on the transfer of copyright will be sent to authors on acceptance of their manuscript for publication. The transfer of copyright from author(s) to publisher must be stated in writing before any manuscript can be published.

### **Title page**

The title page must include the following information: The full title, the affiliation and full addresses of all authors, a running title (maximum 50 characters), indication of the author responsible for correspondence and correction of proofs, and a brief biographical outline.

### **Abstract and keywords**

The abstract should not exceed 200 words. The principal findings and most essential aspects of the study should be emphasized. Up to five keywords or phrases must be submitted for indexing purposes.
