SEEKS Ph. D. PROFESSOR CANDIDATES

The U.S. Army War College is accepting applications from Army Competitive Category officers to fill positions as Professor, USAWC in the following departments and fields of study:

Department of Command, Leadership, and Management (strategic planning, public policy, public administration)

Department of Distance Education (leadership, management, military history)

To enhance the academic credentials of military faculty members serving at the USAWC and to retain this expertise on the faculty, the USAWC selects Army Competitive Category officers to obtain doctoral degrees. These officers will return to the USAWC and serve on the faculty as Professor, USAWC, until their mandatory retirement date.

Principal responsibilities include academic leadership, teaching, and scholarship. Specific duties will include teaching core curriculum as well as graduate electives, faculty development, service on faculty committees, and research. Dedication to excellence in teaching is an absolute requirement of this position. The officer selected for this position should have previous college-level or professional teaching experience. Candidates should hold a Masters degree in a pertinent field, enabling them to complete Ph.D. course work within two years. Applicants must have a strong commitment to the educational, military, physical, and ethical development. Candidates should possess an exemplary military record that includes success in leadership and staff positions at the strategic level. Enrollment in or completion of Senior Service College is required. Candidates should have no more than 22 years of service at time of application. Female and minority officers are encouraged to apply.
