

PET OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES AT CARLISLE BARRACKS

Residents of Carlisle Barracks government quarters are reminded that all pets must be registered with the Carlisle Barracks Veterinary Treatment Facility. Pets should be registered within 10 days of arrival in government quarters.

The following information has been extracted from CBks Reg 40-1 in an on-going effort to remind pet owners of their responsibilities. The privilege of animal ownership on this installation carries with it the responsibility to provide for the well being of the animal.

a. The owner is required to immediately clean up his/her animal's feces when the animal defecates inside or outside the owner's assigned quarters or yard. This is particularly applicable to common yard areas surrounding multiple family dwellings that do not have an identifiable yard such as Young Hall, Stanwix or Coren Apartments.

b. All animals will be controlled at all times by their owners to prevent them from becoming a nuisance or menace to other persons, animals, and property. When outside, dogs shall be kept on a leash (not exceeding 15 feet in length). Animals kept in a fenced area from which they cannot escape need not be on a leash or chained.

c. Animals are not permitted at the Indian Cemetery, BEQ, BOQ, guesthouse facilities, swimming pool, and other recreational facilities.

d. There are two areas on post designated for exercise or training off leash, please see enclosed map. Even in these areas, dogs must be under the control of the owner. Dogs on or off leash that are not under the control of the owner or dogs that become a nuisance or menace to other persons, animals, or property will be apprehended by the Military Police and impounded at the Veterinary Clinic.

e. Tethers for dogs tied outside must not exceed 15 feet in length and must not be tied to trees or shrubs. Dogs that are tethered outside must not come closer than four feet to sidewalks or roads.
